Policy			

- Reciprocal borrowing agreements between (among) specified libraries are part of the operations of the libraries and are to be signed by the Library Directors of the specified libraries. All other signatures are optional.
- 2. Interlibrary loan will be employed as a means to use resources which are not available in the collection. The Fort Saskatchewan Public Library will abide by the guidelines set out in the Provincial Resource Sharing Network Policy.
- 3. The Library will cooperate with the agency responsible for coordinating the Interlibrary Loan service in arranging loans of items to and from our collection.
 - a) the staff will be knowledgeable of the Interlibrary Loan process.
 - b) the Library will make available for loan to other libraries any materials in its possession, subject to the following limitations:
 - the period of loan shall be mutually agreeable,
 - the item(s) shall be part of the collection normally available for loan to patrons
- 4. Displays of materials and other objects for public viewing which are not normally lent will be made available for loan to other libraries at the discretion of the Director.
