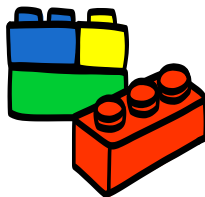

### Baby Literacy Kits

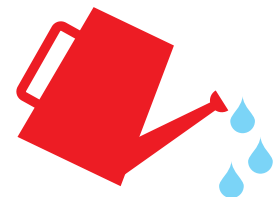

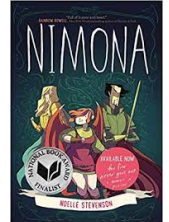

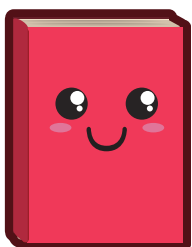
