

## FSPL Green Screen Information

Welcome to the Green Screen Setup at the Fort Saskatchewan Public Library! Follow these simple steps to create your video.

---

### Step 1: Getting Started

You have two options to begin:

1. Borrow Equipment from the Front Desk:
    - Ask for the tripod and green screen iPad.
  2. Use Your Own Device:
    - Apple Devices: Download **iMovie** from the App Store.
    - Android Devices: Download **CapCut** from the Google Play Store.

### Step 2: Choose Your Background

1. Download Background:
    - Use the iPad or your device to download the video or picture you want as your background from the internet.
      - i. Copyright free background options can be found on Unsplash, Pixabay, Pexels, or on any other stock photo website.
  2. Select Preloaded Background:
    - You can also choose from the available background options already loaded on the FSPL iPad. These can be found in Photos.

### Step 3: Record Your Green Screen Clips

1. Position the iPad/your device:
    - Place the iPad/your device in the tripod and adjust it to capture your video in front of the green screen.
  2. Record Your Video:
    - Take the videos you need, making sure to stand clearly in front of the green screen.

### Step 4: Edit Your Videos Together

**For Apple Devices (Using iMovie)**

1. Start A New Project:
  - Open iMovie and select "Movie" from the home screen.

2. Add Your Background:
  - Choose your background video or picture and press “Create Movie.”
3. Add the Green-Screen Clip:
  - Scroll to the start of your background.
  - Tap the Add Media button (+) in the top right corner and select your green-screen video.
  - Tap the More button (...) and select Green/Blue Screen.
4. Fine-Tune Adjustments:
  - Strength: Tap Adjust and move the Strength slider.
  - Crop: Tap Mask and drag the corners to adjust.

### **For Android Devices (Using CapCut)**

1. Upload Background Clips:
  - Open CapCut and start a New Project.
  - Add your background picture or video(s) and tap Add.
2. Add Green Screen Video:
  - Tap Overlay at the bottom.
  - Select Add overlay and choose your green screen video.
  - Pinch the video with your fingers to resize it so it fits the background properly.
3. Remove Green Screen Color:
  - Tap the green screen video.
  - Tap Remove BG.
  - Press Chroma Key and select the green color to remove.
4. Adjust the Effect:
  - Use the Intensity slider to adjust how much of the green is removed.
  - Adjust Shadow if needed to match the lighting.
5. Export Your Video:
  - Tap the check mark to apply changes.
  - Export your video as usual.

### **Step 5: Delete Files (for Library iPad Users)**

After you're done:

1. **Delete Your Files:**
  - Go to both the Photos and iMovie app on the iPad.
  - Delete all of your videos, images, and project files to keep the device ready for the next user.
