Preamble

This code of conduct has been established in order to ensure that your visit to the Library is a positive experience for everyone. We expect your conduct to be respectful, considerate, lawful, safe and responsible.

Code of Conduct

Unacceptable behaviours within the Library include, but are not limited to:

- conduct or language which is excessively noisy, disorderly, abusive, threatening, insulting, and/or harassing.
- behaviour that interferes with any person's comfort and use of the library.
- not adhering to the library's Internet Use Policy.
- photographing and/or filming without prior approval from a senior staff person.
- vandalism, graffiti, damage to or theft of Library property including materials and computers.
- selling, using, possessing or being under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- leaving children who are under the age of 10 unattended or without supervision.
- using in-line skates, skateboards or bicycles in the Library.
- not wearing shirt or shoes.
- Leashed pets may enter the Library for Holds pickup/returns only. Extended visits are permitted by service animals only.
- soliciting, canvassing, selling or distributing unsolicited materials.
- any other unlawful activities.
- not abiding by any measures put in place to protect the health and safety of the library users and staff.

The Library is not responsible for personal belongings that are unattended. You may be required to make available for inspection all bags and carrying cases when leaving the library.

Violation of the Code of Conduct may result in suspension of library privileges, exclusion from the library, cost recovery of damages and/or prosecution.
